



DAVID STOCKMAN, “FATHER OF REAGANOMICS” TO PARTICIPATE IN AMERICATALYST 2016

The session, “One-Trick Pony: A Bucking Fed Throws Off the Housing Market,” takes place on Day 2 of AmeriCatalyst 2016, Tuesday, Nov. 1.

Stockman, known as “the Father of Reaganomics,” developed the popular theory of “trickle-down economics” and was one of the most controversial Directors of the Office of Management and Budget in history. After leaving government, Stockman joined Salomon Brothers and later became a partner of the Blackstone Group.

He is the author of four books, including *The Reagan Economic Plan* (1981); *The Triumph of Politics: Why the Reagan Revolution Failed* (1986); *The Great Deformation: The Corruption of Capitalism in America* (2013) and the just released, *Trumped! A Nation on the Brink of Ruin and How to Bring it Back*.
